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

THINKING ABOUT TECHNOLOGY...



WHAT IS A TACTIVITY?

- A tactile activity that encourages collaboration and engagement.
- Tactile (movable pieces)
- Actively engages students
- Can be used to help teach or to review a concept
- Most are designed for groups of 2–4 students
- Often self-checking
- Very few (if any) directions needed
- No moves are permanent
