What is a TACTivity?

A tactile activity that encourages collaboration and engagement

Tactile (movable pieces)

Actively engages students

Can be used to help teach or review a concept

Most are designed for groups of 2-4 students


Often self-checking

No moves are permanent

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Study Details

Instructor and student perceptions of the use of TACTivities were examined.

Setting:

25 sections of a coordinated pre-calculus course at the same university

Student Participants:

N = 163 out of 900 pre-calculus students 212 students started the survey

Instructor Participants:

N= 9 out of 13 pre-calculus instructors 8 of whom were GTAs 2 had previously used TACTivities

Data Collection:

Qualitative and quantitative data collected using Qualtrics

Tools:

Modified CEI and LOES-S/T instruments
